ORDINANCE NO. 2025-875

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF BREEZEWOOD DRIVE TO DEER CREEK DRIVE AND HALL DRIVE TO BETTER FACILITATE EMERGENCY AND DELIVERY SERVICES AND AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MAP AND ZONING MAP OF PENN TOWNSHIP TO REFLECT SAID CHANGES**

WHEREFORE, as a result of development, Breezewood Drive currently has two branches and three terminuses;

WHEREFORE, having two roads with the same name is confusing to residents and visitors alike, and can cause significant delays in the event of an emergency;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township Commissioners of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania:

Section 1. Breezewood Drive, from the point where it bisects at 39.795842, -76.956788 to the point where it intersects with Hall Drive at 39.790512, -76.954449 shall hereinafter be named Deer Creek Drive.

Section 2. Breezewood Drive, from the point where it intersects with Hall Drive at 39.790512, -76.954449 and where it intersects with Black Rock Road at 39.781212, -76.953033, shall hereinafter be named Hall Drive.

Section 3. The Official Map of the Township shall be amended to reflect the street name changes adopted by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The Zoning Map shall be amended to reflect the street name changes adopted by this Ordinance.


