

**RESOLUTION NO. 1071**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR AND THE  
PUBLIC SALE OF EXCESS PUBLIC WORKS EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, Penn Township (“Township”) is the owner of a 2007 Case Wheel Loader,  
and

WHEREAS, the Township purchased the equipment for use in the Public Works  
Departments, and

WHEREAS, the equipment has outlived its useful life for the Township, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of §1501(II) of the First Class Township Code, the Township is  
authorized to convey by sale personal property where such sale is deemed to be in the best  
interest of the Township; and

WHEREAS, Section 1501(II) of the First Class Township Code provides that no personal  
property shall be sold for an amount in excess of \$1,000.00 except to the highest bidder after due  
notice by advertisement for bids or public auction, published one time, not less than ten (10) days  
prior to the date for the opening of the bids or the date of the public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that it is in its best interest to sell the public  
works and zoning equipment.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT SO RESOLVED, that the Penn Township Board of  
Commissioners authorizes the sale of the equipment by public auction in accordance with the  
provisions of Section 1501 of the First-Class Township Code, including, but not limited to, the  
advertisement of such auction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public auction shall end on March 13, 2026.


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proceeds from the sale of the above-
