

**PENN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 889

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CERTAIN SEWER FACILITIES AS PUBLIC SEWER FACILITIES, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, LOCATED IN PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, WITH DESIGNATED RIGHTS-OF-WAY, AS MORE FULLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED AS REQUIRED BY CHAPTER 245 OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP CODE, AND ORDINANCE 683.

The Board of Commissioners of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. The sewer facilities described more fully below are adopted as public sewers in Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania.

SANITARY SEWER RUNS EXISTING MH 309-1C TO EXISTING MH 309-1 WITHIN MAPLE LANE.

BEGINNING AT Manhole #309-1D at centerline station 16+35.56 of Maple Lane: thence through the cartway of Maple Lane for a distance of 100.6 feet to Manhole #309-1C at centerline station 17+35.93 offset L-3.2' of Maple Lane: thence through the cartway of Maple Lane for a distance of 339.25 feet to Manhole #309-1B at centerline station 20+75.07 offset R-1.5' of Maple Lane: thence through the cartway of Maple Lane for a distance of 193.75 feet to Manhole #309-1A at centerline station 22+68.81 offset R-1.7' of Maple Lane; thence through the cartway of Maple Lane for a distance of 196.55 feet to Existing Manhole #309-1 at centerline station 24+65.29 offset L-2.5' of Maple Lane and near the intersection with Clover Lane. Total Length of Sanitary Sewer Run 830.15 feet.

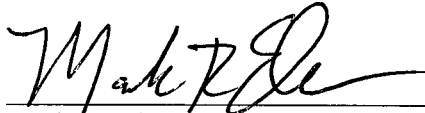
Section 2. The aforementioned sanitary sewers have been constructed and are or have been ready for use.

Section 3. Said sanitary sewers will be available to serve residents abutting said street sewers and will be available in the street to serve such future residents and business establishments as and when they are constructed and the abutting process.

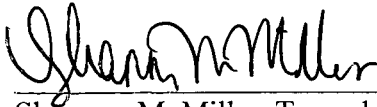
